### Bulletin Briefs – June 2010

## *From Barbara . . .*

Life is full of opportunities for us to make judgments. But Jesus tells us not to judge other people or their motives. Jesus is about forgiveness. In 2002 Pope John Paul II's theme for World Day of Peace was "No Peace Without Justice, No Justice Without Forgiveness." In other words, peace and justice are based in forgiveness. And forgiveness is based on relationships. We can't really forgive if we are not in relationship with the person in need of forgiveness. Today's gospel emphasizes the relationship that Jesus had with the men and women who followed him. At the end of this passage it specifically mentions the names of the women. Men and women, clergy, consecrated religious and lay are all necessary for the mission of the church. Take time this week to forgive if necessary and to contemplate how you play a part in the mission of peace and justice of the church.

A few weeks ago the Vatican approved the new English translation of the Roman Missal. This is the book that contains all the prayers and instructions for our liturgies. Over the next year we will have a variety of ways available to learn about what the changes are, why we made the changes, and how it will affect us. It is estimated that we will begin using the new missal in Advent 2011 so we have some time to familiarize ourselves with the new prayers.

Thanks to everyone who participated in the Bright Envelope fundraiser. At the time I'm writing this I don't know the final amount we collected but I'm very grateful for your generosity. The new roof is expected to last at least 30 years so your contribution will last long into the future. Contributions can still be turned in. We'll have the total next week.
