

Town Manager's Report
JUNE 2012

Streets:

- Staff hung the new flower baskets on the square.
- Staff repaired a number of street lights.
- Staff installed "No Parking" signs on Silo Hill Road.
- Staff installed flags on the street lights and made other preparations for Community Day.

Water:

- Rainbow Lake is at the spillway level.
- The roughing filters are being backwashed three times per day and the DE filters are being done once per week.
- MDE has completed the inspection of Rainbow Lake and the spillway.
- Our wells are now averaging about 4.5' below their May 2011 levels.
- Water production and consumption. We produced and purchased an average of 311,948 GPD. We consumed an average of 269,452 GPD.

The difference is "Backwash Water" ... (13.6%). We purchased 507,400 gallons of water from MSM this month.

- 56.0% of this water came from wells.
- 5.4% of this water came from Mt. St. Mary's.
- 38.6% of this water came from Rainbow Lake.

Wastewater:

- The overland flow treatment system is up and running for the season.
- We had the backup generator at the WWTP serviced.
- We received about 3.9" of precipitation this month (the average is 4.3").
 - We have a precipitation **DEFICIT** of 8.4" (up from 6.5" in April) over the last six months. The average precipitation for the period from January 1 thru June 30 is 23.2". We have received 14.8" for that period.
- Wastewater Treatment:
 - We treated an average of 433,000 GPD (consumed 269,452 GPD) which means that 37.8% of the wastewater treated this month was "wild water".
 - We had no spills of untreated sewerage in the month of June.
 - We exceeded the plant's design capacity on 3 days in the month of June:

06/01	1,894,000 GPD	06/02	1,156,000 GPD	06/12	1,108,000 GPD
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Trash: Trash pickup will remain Mondays for the remainder of the month of July.

Parks:

- Staff performed monthly maintenance in all parks.
- Staff has installed new mulch around the playground equipment in the Silo Hill Park.
